Short biography

Julian Plottka is a Senior Researcher at the Institut für Europäische Politik, Berlin, and a Research Associate at the University of Passau. He has studied political science at the University of Potsdam, Universitet i Bergen and the Free University Berlin. His research covers reforms of the EU political system, its legitimacy, including the European Citizens' Initiative, and relations between the European Union and Central Asia. Mr. Plottka has managed a number of research projects, including the "Study on Strengthening the Democratic Legitimacy of the EU", the "Study on the European Added Value of the European Citizens' Initiative" and the project "The Relaunch of Europe. Mapping Member State Reform Interests". He is part of the Jean Monnet Network "The EU and the EEU: Between Conflict and Competition, Convergence and Cooperation". His most recent publications include "Making the Conference on the Future of Europe a Success", "Young Central Asia: Recommendations to the German Government for the Implementation of the EU-Central Asia Strategy", and "Potenziale deutsch-österreichischer Kooperation".
